**National Transition of Care Coalition:** GAPNA will be joining NTOCC as consulting Associate Members. Consulting Associate Members participate in testing, piloting, and commenting on programs and tools developed by the Coalition.

**APRN Gerontological Specialist Certification Examination Study Guide:** The Education Committee is working with the Board of Directors to develop study materials to support the APRN Gerontological Specialist Cortication Exam (GS-C).
